- Attend/report to 3 OAGS Board meetings in Toronto per annum*
- Present a brief Resident Update during the OAGS Annual Meeting each fall (Toronto)
- Assist with registration on the morning of OAGS Annual Meeting (before mtg begins)
- Communicate with OAGS Resident Liaisons on an on-going basis
- Contribute to events/communications pertaining to General Surgery Residents
